Dear Parents & Carers,

In addition to the letter: 'What to expect when we re-open on Monday 8th March', I am writing with further details for the return to school next week.

- On arrival, for Early Years and Key Stage One pupils, there will be an adult from your child's group waiting in the playgrounds. If necessary, Early Years and Key Stage One parents can take their child to the class teacher/teaching assistant in the playground.
- Key Stage Two pupils will need to make their way to the Key Stage Two playground.
 Parents will not be allowed to the Key Stage Two playground (staff will be available at the main gate to support where necessary).
- It is very important that children are in school as quickly as possible and parents leave the school site as quickly as possible; therefore, please ensure you arrive promptly and adhere to social distancing rules at all times.
- Year 6 children will use the driveway entrance and walk straight down to the huts. A
 member of staff will be on the driveway gates.
- Year 1 children will use the driveway entrance to access the classroom.
- Siblings can arrive and leave together; please contact the school office if you need further information on this.

- There will not be an opportunity to have a detailed discussion with teachers at start/finish times. If you need to make an appointment with your child's teacher, please contact the school office, and by phone wherever possible, or teachers directly via Class Dojo.
- The children will be provided with the equipment they need in class (pens, pencils, rulers etc). Government guidance recommends that the children do not bring their own equipment into school, including pencil cases.
- Please ensure the children are dressed appropriately dependent on the weather and do not bring unnecessary items into school as far as possible. The children can bring hats, sun-cream and coats whenever needed.

All arrangements will be regularly reviewed.

Also for your information:

- School meals, including hot meals, will be provided as normal and need to be paid for using Parent Pay (meals will be £2.10).
- Every day, the children will need:
 - o school uniform
 - o a named water bottle
 - Book bags
 - PE kits (can be worn to school on PE days)
