Road Closure

I have been informed by East Sussex Highways Agency that Avis Road will be closed for three days next week for surfacing works. The works were originally due to start on Monday 9th September, but I gather this has been postponed until Wednesday 11th September. The road will be closed from 9.00am to 3.30pm each day which will impact on your journeys to and from school. I understand the works will begin at Denton Corner Roundabout and work northwards, so access to Denton on Wednesday will be via the A26 during these hours. I have requested regular updates on the works and will pass on any information I receive. There are also surfacing works on the fly-over and in other parts of Newhaven which I believe start today. So in short, if you are travelling by car, you should expect some disruption to your journey over the next week.
